To Whom It May Concern:

We wish to offer our professional recommendation for Stephen Bliss, who served as our high school principal for three years, from fall of 2006 until spring of 2009.

Until Stephen Bliss took the helm and challenged us to define the role of visual arts education at Tantasqua, the capabilities of our art teaching staff and the value of our visual arts program were often taken for granted. With Mr. Bliss' administrative support, visual art at Tantasqua gained its voice across our district and won new recognition for its service in our learning community. During Mr. Bliss' tenure we established a student art gallery, a permanent installation including display spaces spanning one hundred feet of hallway. Stephen Bliss is a quick learner. Not professing to be perfect, Mr. Bliss constantly assesses his participation in the educational process. He has visibly grown professionally in three years as our principal. We regret he could not remain with us to serve another three years.

A school system which hires him will benefit from having Stephen Bliss on its staff. We feel privileged to have experienced Mr. Bliss as our leader. We are pleased to offer our support for Mr. Bliss, to receive an assignment in administration where he may continue to develop professionally and lead another school district on its path to success.
